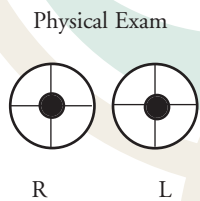

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EXAMINATIONS

1. If you are pregnant, please advise us by telephone prior to your visit.
2. Please bring any previous films to your appointments that are relevant to the exam being performed for comparison.
3. Diabetic/Elderly/Disabled: Please call our office in advance of your appointment to arrange a modified preparation or special assistance if necessary.

**Preparations for specific examinations (Further details can be obtained from the radiology department at (091) 785 600)**

#### **MRI without Contrast**

No preparation required. Hair pins/clips must be removed prior to your examination. Please advise us if you are pregnant or have a cardiac pacemaker, cardiac valves, implanted cardiac defibrillator, aneurysm clips, cochlea rear implants, heart stent, and/or retinal implants.

#### **MRI with Contrast/MRA/MRV**

Do not eat or drink anything for two hours prior to examination.

#### **MRI Abdomen**

Do not eat or drink anything for seven hours prior to examination.

#### **MRI Head**

No eye make-up should be worn.

#### **CT with Oral Contrast**

Do not eat or drink anything for four hours prior to examination.

#### **CT without injected/IV Contrast**

No preparation required.

#### **PET/CT**

Please call our PET/CT Department (091) 785 626 for detailed instructions.

Do not eat or drink anything for seven hours prior to examination.

#### **GI Series, Small Bowel Series**

If you are over 65: Clear liquid diet for twenty-four hours prior to examination, and at 7:00p.m. the evening prior to examination. If you are under 65: Detailed instructions will be sent to you by our Radiology Department. For any of the studies above, do not eat or drink anything for 12 hours prior to your examination.

#### **Mammography**

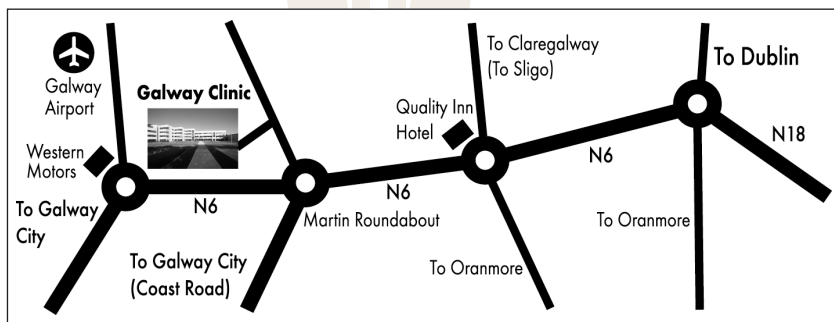
Please notify scheduler if you have breast implants. Do not use deodorant, perfume or dusting powder on the underarms or breasts prior to your examination.

#### **Nuclear Medicine**

No preparation.

#### **Ultrasound Examinations**

1. Abdomen/Gallbladder - Do not eat or drink anything for six hours prior to examination.
2. Pelvic - drink 1 litre of clear liquid approximately one hour before scheduled examination. DO NOT urinate after drinking the above; you must have fluid in your bladder for this procedure.
